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Subject: Private, Member-Owned Power Carts

Effective: April 1, 2010

1.0 Members who are already registered cart owners (registered owner/partner and/or owner's spouse) will be permitted to retain private power cart privileges at Sussex Golf & Curling Club subject to signing an annual operating agreement and payment of the applicable annual storage and/or trail fees no later than May 31 of each golf season. Delinquent payment will be considered a default of private cart privileges and the member's name(s) may be permanently removed from the list of members with private cart privileges.

2.0 No additional privately owned power golf carts will be permitted/accepted at Sussex Golf & Curling Club.

3.0 Registered cart owners are to be the only operators of their carts; they are not permitted to loan their carts to any other individuals.

4.0 Registered cart owners are permitted to loan their power cart to Sussex Golf & Curling Club for use on occasions that necessitate such.

5.0 Each registered cart owner is permitted to store one set of clubs on/with his/her power cart.

6.0 Sussex Golf & Curling Club is not responsible for any damage and/or loss incurred while the power cart is in storage. Cart owners will be required to ensure that their own home insurance policy provides such coverage while their carts and/or clubs are stored on Club property.

7.0 Private carts must, at a minimum, be in better condition than the worst cart in the Club's own fleet, as assessed by the Club's management team. Any improvements must conform to the Club's standards with regard to appearance, tastefully maintained with no profane or vulgar decorative touches. Corporate advertising and/or logos are not allowed on member-owned power carts.

8.0 All power carts are to be in good working condition with necessary repairs/improvements made before they are allowed on the golf course. When feasible, Club staff may perform minor repairs on private carts throughout the season, as the course work schedule allows.

i) A towing fee equal to the price of a 9-hole cart rental will be imposed on each owner whose cart breaks down and requires towing off the course by Club staff. This fee includes use of a Club cart (as available) for the remainder of the member's round.

ii) An hourly labor fee will be set by the Board of Directors and imposed for all work performed by Club staff on private carts.

9.0 All private power carts will be assigned an identification number by the Club which must be displayed in the stipulated location on each car.

10.0 Storage and/or trail fees will be reviewed and set each year by the Board of Directors in consultation with the appropriate Club Staff.

11.0 Owners, co-owners must be active golf members; requests for exceptions must be made in writing to the Board of Directors who will assess such on a case-by-case basis but will require storage and trail fees to be paid regardless.

12.0 Appeals relating to this policy must be made in writing to the Board of Directors who will review such on a case-by-case basis.

13.0 This policy will be reviewed annually by the Board of Directors, with consideration given to any changes required to keep it relevant and current.

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
