

## Policy \_\_\_\_\_

Subject: **Payment of Golf Dues and Fees**

Effective: June 25, 2008

**1.0 Purpose:** To provide a clear outline as to how and when golf dues and related fees must be paid, along with a clear definition of the timeframe to which those dues and fees are applied.

**2.0** A golf membership or annual pass for cart, driving range, etc, is good for one **season** only and will not be recognized in the following season (unless a credit for same has been issued per Club policy).

**3.0** Golf privileges are granted on a “pay before you play” basis; anyone who has not paid dues or arranged a payment installment plan through the General Manager’s office will be required to pay daily fees. *A maximum of two* green fees may be deducted from the price of the membership when the member pays, whether 9- or 18-hole, or a combination of both. Receipts for the daily fees paid, *in the customer’s name*, must be turned in at that time in order to have the credit applied.

**4.0** Installment plans for the payment of golf dues will be offered to anyone who wishes to enroll. Details will be determined and made available well in advance of each new season.

**5.0** Payments for seasonal driving range and power cart passes are due before first use each season. Daily fees will be charged until seasonal passes are paid; there will be no credit given for such when the seasonal payment is made. Range and cart passes may be added to any golf dues installment payment plan.

**6.0 Administration of the Policy:** The Payment of Golf Dues and Fees policy shall be administered by the General Manager.

**7.0** This policy will be reviewed annually by the Board of Directors, with consideration given to any changes required to keep it relevant and current.
