Arriving at Sussex Golf and Curling Club:

Review the screening questions before entering the curling club.

Enter using Pro Shop door

- 1) Wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose.
- 2) Disinfect hands
- 3) Sign sheet (name and telephone number)
- 4) Arrive dressed for play (except footwear). Players will sit at designated table (based on ice playing on) to change into curling shoes and leave outdoor clothes at designated chair.

Lounge Area

- 1) Wear mask when inside the club. Mask may be removed if seated and eating/ drinking.
- 2) Pay your curling fees at bar (if applicable).
- 3) Bring your own water bottle(filled) or purchase bottled water at bar.
- 4) Bar service will be available. Please wear your mask and follow the physical distancing markers on the floor.

Departing Exit building by the front door (towards the parking lot). Wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose.

Playing the game/ On the Ice

1) Ice number, colour of stone and hammer will be determined by the league coordinator before going on the ice. Sheets 1 and 3 will start at the “away” house – rocks will be placed and disinfected after ice preparation and returned at the end of the game (by the players).

Instead of shaking hands, give a friendly wave or tap brooms.

2) Equipment (brooms, stabilizers, extender sticks, sliders): Do not share equipment. If you use club equipment there will be two storage areas, “clean” and “dirty”. Select your equipment from the “clean” area at the beginning of the game and then replace to the “dirty” area at the end of the game.

A club volunteer will disinfect equipment after each game.

3) Once at your designated sheet you may remove your mask.

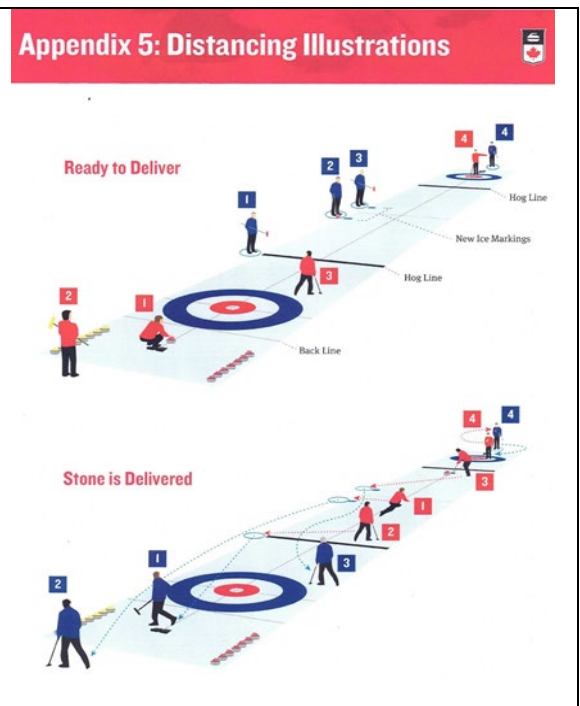
4) Stones:

- After individual practice wipe down all stones used.
- At the start of the game, one person from each team will wipe down stones.
- Each player selects 2 stones. If you rotate position continue to use the same stones.
Do not touch other stones with hands. Use feet or broom to move stones.

5) Traffic flow

Delivering Team: The player whose turn it is to deliver is in the hack. The non-sweeping player is on the backboards. The sweeping player is at the T-Line. Once the stone has been released, the player who delivered the stone proceeds down the centre line of the ice until the halfway point to the marking on the side or to the hog line if he/she has another stone to deliver. After the stone comes to rest, the sweeper proceeds to the halfway markings. The non-sweeper travels to the halfway mark or the hog line if he/she delivers the next team stone.

Non-Delivering Team: The two sweepers of the non-delivering team should be positioned on designated marking while the other team is throwing. The player of the non-delivering team whose turn it is next to deliver should be positioned at hogline on the same side as the two sweepers. The Skip (or mate) will stand on the backboards but no closer than the hack.



6) One sweeper – can follow the stone into the house until stone stops.

7) Skips NEVER sweep any stones. The skip of the non-delivering team must stay in the hack area until all stones come to rest.

8) Mates will clear all the stones from the house after an end. Using feet and brooms, not hands.

9) One person (mate) will post score for both teams. After the game that person will disinfect the numbers and replace in storage bin for next game.

10) Leaving the ice – you must put your mask on. Return to your designated table in the lounge to change footwear and enjoy a beverage and conversation with your curling friends.
