



**Sussex Golf and Curling Club
Policy: ALCOHOL**

Definitions:

1. *Liquor License*: shall mean the license granted by and under the Liquor Control Act R.S.N.B. Chapter L-10 and the Regulations legislated under the Act, hereinafter called the "LICENSE".

Preamble: It is crucial to the safety of our Patrons, as well as to the maintenance of our License, that the Club and its Patrons follow the Act and such other provincially legislated rules and regulations related to the sale and use of Alcohol in New Brunswick.

- 1.0 The Club shall adhere to all rules and regulations pertaining to the Club's License as granted by the Province of New Brunswick.
 - 1.1 Signage shall be posted throughout the facility to advise patrons of the Club Alcohol Policy.
 - 1.2 The Manager shall be responsible under this Policy for the training of all Club Bartending Staff and Volunteers in a Responsible Beverage or similar program.
 - 1.3 Alcoholic beverages other than those purchased on the Club premises are not permitted. Non-compliance of this Policy shall see the matter referred to the Club's Discipline Policy.
- 2.0 For special functions, Patrons may make special orders of wine or beer from the local liquor store through the Manager. A corking fee will be applied to each bottle and charged directly to the Patron.

Administered by: The Alcohol Policy shall be administered by the General Manager.

Reviewed by: This Policy shall be reviewed by the Board as required.
